If you need help in answering any of the questions, do not hesitate to ask the enumerator or to use the "Freefone" service mentioned below. The enumerator has to ensure that you have completed the form and you should give him any further information he may need for this purpose.

The form is used only for compiling statistics and when you have completed it in accordance with the instructions, it will be treated as CONFIDENTIAL and no information about named individuals will be passed by the Census Office to any other Government Department or any other authority or person. If anyone employed in taking the Census improperly discloses information you provide, he will be liable to prosecution. Similarly, you must not disclose information which anyone (for example, a visitor or boarder) gives you to Tenable you to complete the form.

The legal obligation to fill in the whole form rests on YOU, but each person who has to be included is required to give you the information you need. However, if anyone aged 16 or over does not wish to give you his or her personal information, the enumerator or local Census Officer should be asked for an individual form and official envelope in which to return it. Then you need answer only questions 1a, 3 and 4 for that person. If the person leaves his completed form with you for collection, pass the envelope unopened to the enumerator.

Completion of this form is compulsory under the Census Act 1920 and there are penalties of up to £50 for failing to comply with the requirements described above or for giving false information.
