
### Notice to all users:

The documentation was processed through either Adobe's <u>Acrobat Capture 3.0</u> or ParaVision/<u>XMLCities PageGenie Pro 4.0</u> software, and then edited with Adobe's <u>Acrobat 4.05</u> software to create this PDF document. Roman script documents were processed using Acrobat Capture's or PageGenie Pro's optical character recognition filters to extract as much electronic text from the pages as possible, but no attempt has been made to check the resulting document's spelling or grammar. You may perform text searches on these documents, but due to limitations in character recognition technology and the quality of the individual documents, be aware that some words or phrases may not show up in the search even if they appear to be in the document.

All of the documents have thumbnail views and bookmarks embedded in them to aid the user in finding specific pages as quickly as possible (these are visible from the tabs in the left column of this document). Each document is stored in a PDF "Searchable Image (Exact)" format, which preserves the original scan quality while embedding electronic text (if available) behind the scanned image.
